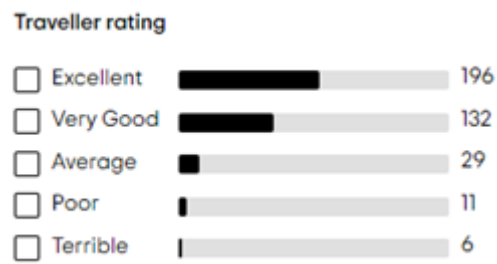

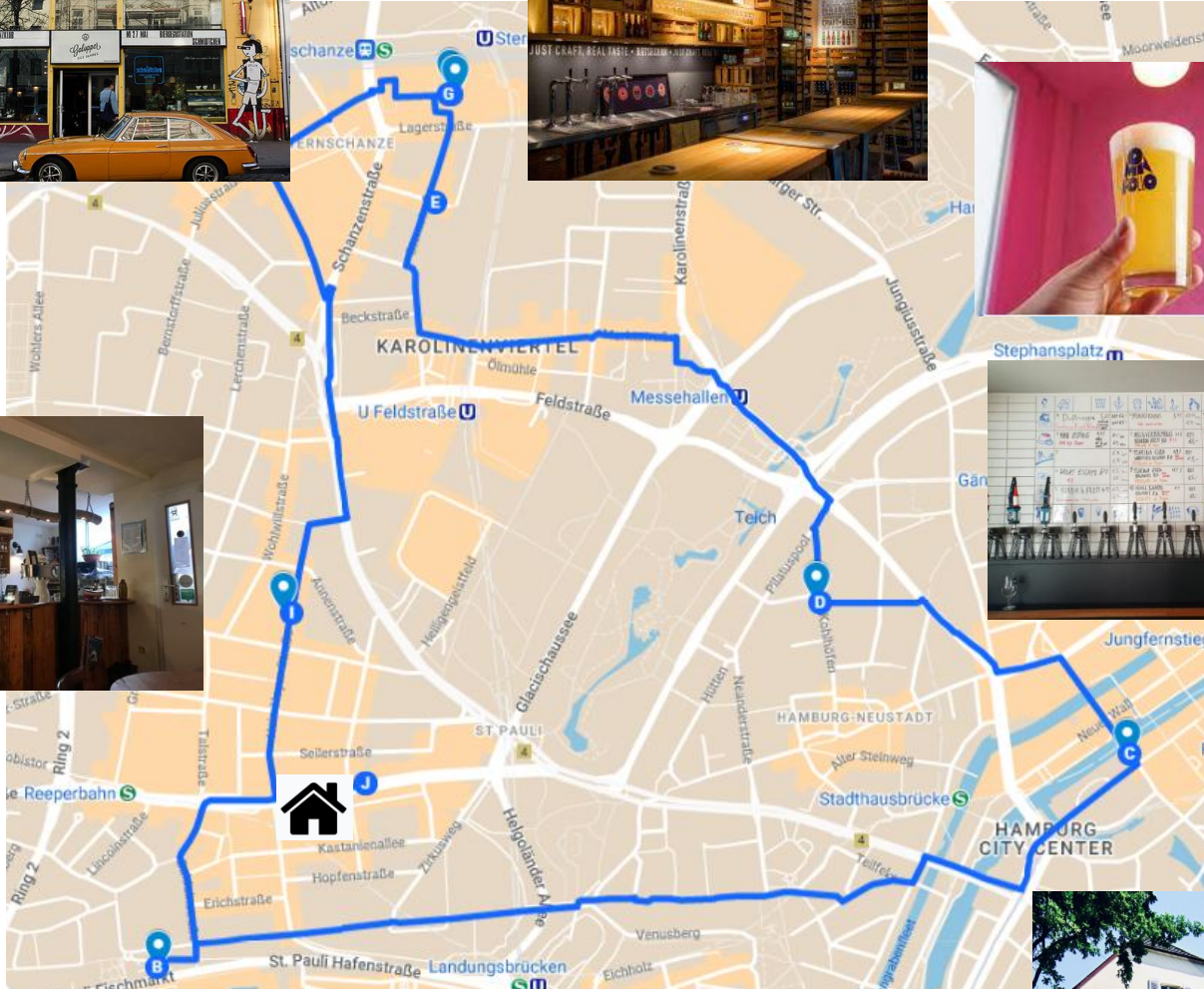

Germany uses the following travel adaptors:



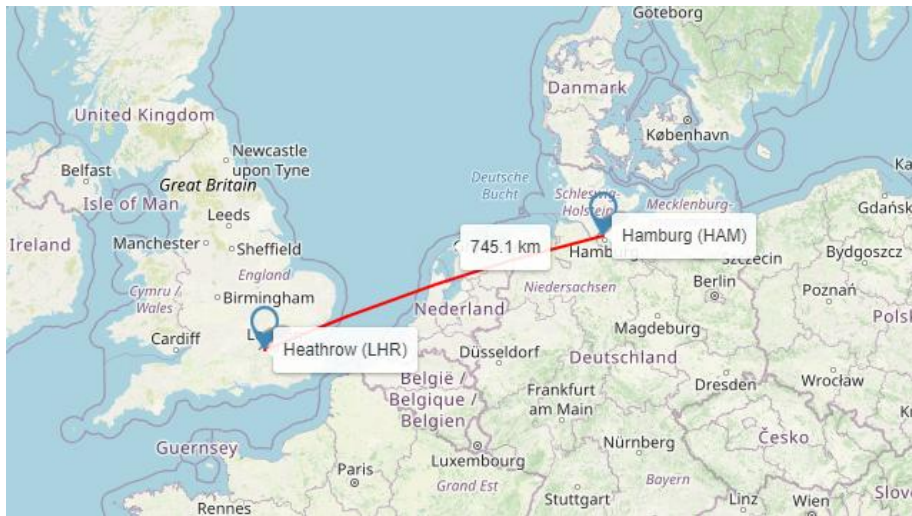
Ear plugs will be supplied by Pyjama Park for a good night sleep.
